Brief History of Baring Union Christian College, Batala



Baring Union Christian College owes its existence to the vision and devotion shared and nurtured by Rev. Francis Henry Baring and Miss Charlotte Marie Tucker and many other education reformers. With mutual support Rev. Baring and Miss Tucker established Baring School in 1934. To serve and empower the people of the region, the school was upgraded to a college in 1944 up to intermediate classes. After partition, this was the only Christian College in North-West of Delhi. A full graduate program was introduced in 1948 and Post graduation was introduced in 1966. Baring is one of the oldest colleges in Punjab affiliated to Panjab University and later to Guru Nanak Dev University. Interestingly, the country mansion of Maharaja Sher Singh, (son of Maharaja Ranjit Singh) was chosen as an ideal setting for learning by Rev. Baring. Baring, co-educational, partly residential college with about 2000 students and more than 70 faculty members, is committed to provide high quality undergraduate education in Humanities, Science, Computer Science and Information Technology and Commerce along with post graduate education in English, Hindi, Punjabi, Computer Science and Information Technology. Over the years, Baring has built upon its strong history and legacy by ever striving with perseverance towards achieving the vision of its missionaries "of providing a community of well educated, successfully employed and positively engaged citizens who can contribute successfully in nation building."

About Dr. Ram Singh Library



Baring Union Christian College Library was established on January 15, 1960, with the mission to spread the light of knowledge in Batala and the surrounding sub-urban areas. The College Library stores a vast collection of books, journals and other non book reading material. For many years, the library staff helped to spread literacy in the remotest areas by sending books on wheels. The three storey library building has a seating capacity for 500 students at a time. The building equips all amenities for serious reading. At present, the library has more than 81,891 books on way. It is a member of National Library Information Services Infrastructure for scholarly content. The library has a rare collection of rare books. A significant number of books / documents are more than two centuries old which are not available elsewhere in this region. The College Library is renamed as "Dr. Ram Singh Library", in memory of former Principal Dr. Ram Singh. He was the first man who provided open shelf-system in the library.

Aims / Objectives of FDP

The Faculty Development Program aims to sharpen the skills of teaching fraternity and researchers in more ways than one. There are three prime areas about which meaningful knowledge will be imparted.

How to create and utilize Academic Identity : Academic Identity is a, unique, permanent identifier that a scholar/ researcher possesses and controls for his/her lifetime. It distinguishes one from other researchers across disciplines, borders, and time. By using academic identity, one can connect with one's professional contribution—affiliations, grants, publications, peer review, and more. Researchers can use these Ids (Scopus ID, ORCID ID, Google Scholar ID, Microsoft Academic ID, Vidwan ID) to share the academic information with other systems, ensuring that one gets recognition for all the contributions, saving time and effort, and reducing the risk of errors. There is a greater likelihood that an Academic Identity may become the pre-requisite for any kind of publication in reputed journals in the coming days.

Research Information Management System : The FDP will focus on how to organize the research related data and how such organization may benefit the scholars in the academic field. The faculty will be trained to understand Research Information Management System and it's role to showcase their research contribution to the peer group and how the data/information can be managed & repurposed in multiple ways.

Massive Open Online Courses and E-content Development: It is a vibrant and wide area which teachers may explore and invest their time and talent for improving their credentials for career promotions. By such exercise, their parent institution are benefited from NAAC perspectives. During the FDP, an extensive training will be provided to create MOOCs and e-content which is sure to enhance the skills of teaching staff.
